Leaver Destinations and Results

In 2019 Claremont Senior School has seen a rise in achievement at A Level for a fourth successive year. Whilst grades have plateaued across the country the school has continued to develop impressively. With more than a third of results graded at A* or A, the school has seen improvements across the whole range of subjects. Art, Sport, Mathematics and French had particularly strong results, as did the Extended **Project Qualification** which the school has championed since its Sixth Form opened in 2015.

A* to B grades have risen by 7% while the A* to C grades improved by over 10%. Claremont students progress on to further education at a range of universities including:
