ACADEMIC

- Rated '**Outstanding**' by the UK Government's school inspectorate Ofsted
- 2-year GCSE (Year 10 & 11)
- 2-year A Level & Btec courses (Year 12 & 13)
- 'Access' pre-A Level foundation. Intended for international students with low level English, age 15/16. They study between 1 and 3 terms of intensive English and A Level preparation, prior to starting A Level proper the following September

SPORT

- Claremont Football Academy (CFA) All CFA students follow a unique programme blending academic study (GCSE or A Levels) with professional football development. High standard required, and selective. Applicants need to either attend a trial at the school, or send in a video clip and coach's report. N.B. Applicants will also need to attend the interview with Head of Boarding.

STUDENT HEALTH AND WELLBEING

- Dedicated member of the senior leadership team (Assistant Head International/ Director of Boarding) solely responsible for taking care of specific educational and pastoral needs of international students.
- Promote open and transparent school / parent relationships to ensure students quickly settle and flourish at school.
- Over 50% of the boarding staff reside on the premises and are on call day and night.
- Team of visiting teachers assist students with homework and ensure continuity of work.
- On-site Boarding matrons issue medication, looking after sick students and taking boarders to medical appointments.
- Matrons work in close collaboration with the School Nurse who visits each boarding house weekly.
- Experienced boarding team is fully dedicated to providing a 'home from home' for our students.
