- What will I learn about? The science of human mind, behaviour and experience; why people behave the way they do, why mental illness occurs and how we can treat it. The course covers social influence, memory, childhood attachment, function of the brain, criminal behaviour, adult relationships and mental disorders including depression, phobias, OCD, schizophrenia and associated research methods.
